The 2017 Solar Eclipse

A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between the Sun and the Earth and when the Moon partially blocks the Sun. Although we view this as a unique and interesting event, some ancient cultures attributed eclipses to supernatural phenomena and regarded them as bad omens. The Sun seems to disappear during the day!

Since looking directly at the Sun can lead to permanent eye damage or blindness, special eye protection or indirect viewing techniques should be used when viewing a solar eclipse.
